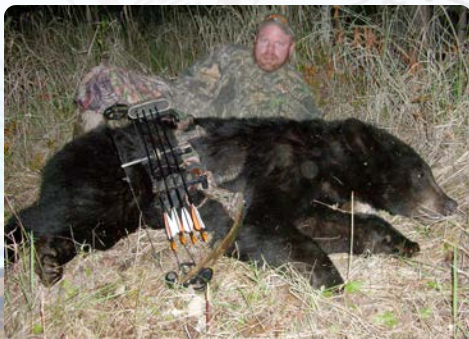
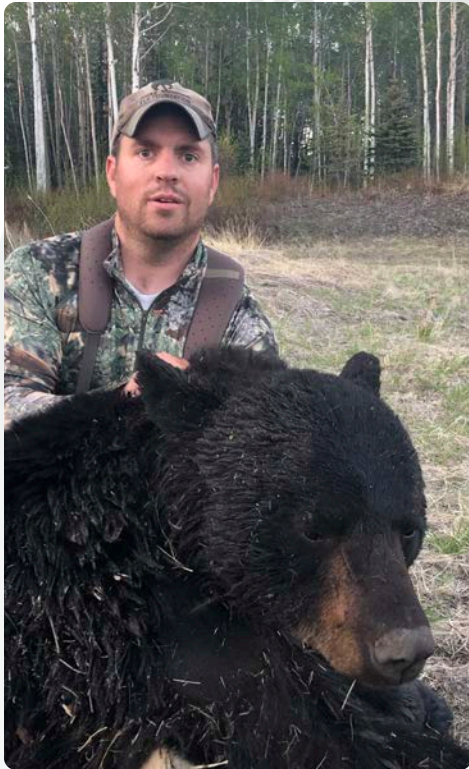

Additional license fees

When adding an additional species to your hunt. The license fee for that species will be added to the fees shown in the pricing schedule. License fees are subject to change each year as they are adjusted annually by the Alberta Government.



Booking Information

To ensure your hunt is locked in we require a deposit of 50% of the cost of your hunt. Please include with your deposit the number of hunters in your group and the species each hunter wishes to hunt and the number of non-hunters in your group if any. All permits are limited so please be clear with this information when listing the desired species. Also include the complete name, address, phone number, email address of the main contact person in your group.

Once your deposit has been received we will send a contract / liability waiver for each member of your group. They must be filled in completely, signed and returned. We will then verify your hunt, sign them on our end and send you a completed copy for your records. Once these steps are completed your hunt will be 100% locked in for the dates you selected. Always carry a copy of your hunting contract for proof of your hunt if asked by customs when crossing the border.

Final payment will be due well before your hunt dates. The exact date will be clearly identified on your paperwork.

If booking more than one year in advance a small non-refundable deposit of \$2000.00 per hunter will hold your hunt until December 1st of the year prior to your hunt. The balance of your deposit will be due by this date in order to continue holding your hunt. Late payments will be subject to a 10% late fee. Payments that are more than 30 days late will result in your hunt being canceled. All payments are non refundable.



Getting Here

DRIVING – If driving up for your hunt you will be met in Fairview, Alberta which is approx. 1.5 hours North of Grande Prairie and 5.5 hours NW of Edmonton. Driving is a great way to come up if you intend to take your meat home with you.

FLYING – If you are flying into Canada you will need to book your flights into Grande Prairie, Alberta where we will pick you up and drop you off again following your hunt. If you wish to return to the airport early at an unscheduled time once your hunt is completed there will be a service charge of \$250.00 USD per trip.

Customs – Border Crossing

U.S. residents and clients from other countries travelling through the United States and coming to Canada please note that Passports are required for entry back into the United States as well as into other countries. Passports are required.

All non-Canadians coming to Canada from other countries must comply with Canadian immigration rules and regulations regarding legal admission to Canada regardless of intention or reason for coming to Canada. Contact the U.S. Fish & Game Department to obtain up-to-date information on regulations.

Firearms Information

For hunters who bring their own firearms into Canada, a confirmed Non-Resident Firearms Declaration (RCMP 5589 / CAFC 909) will serve as a license and registration. This form must be presented in triplicate, unsigned, to a Canada Customs Officer at your first point of entry into Canada. There is a small fee for this which is not included in your hunt price. Import Regulations

Check with your local authorities for import regulations into your country and any country you may be travelling through. Remember – export permits may be required for each country you leave.

Trip Insurance

It is highly recommended that all clients purchase trip insurance to protect them in

the case of the un-expected. We have seen many issues over the years causing clients to not make their hunt at the last minute or having to leave shortly after their arrival for something at home. Adequate insurance to cover these situations is well worth the cost.

Meat Left Behind

Clients who do not want their wild game meat or parts of their wild game meat must still have this unwanted meat processed at their cost. The unwanted meat will then be left in our care and it will be distributed to families in need. This is a great way to give back to the area.

Hunting Camp

We use a variety of hunting camps depending on the time of year, species hunted and desire of the hunter. They range from remote tent camps, mobile trailers, hotels and specialty locations. We can cater to all requests for your group. Some requests may require additional costs.

Terrain and Hunting Methods

For the most part our hunting terrain is flat. We have a mixed boreal forest of pine, spruce, aspen, willow, alder and buck brush. Generally speaking we start our day in the vehicle and drive to an active hunting area. Depending on the species being hunted, we may stay with the pickup but usually we are hunting on foot or atv in order to access more remote locations. Once your trophy is harvested we will prepare it for transport.

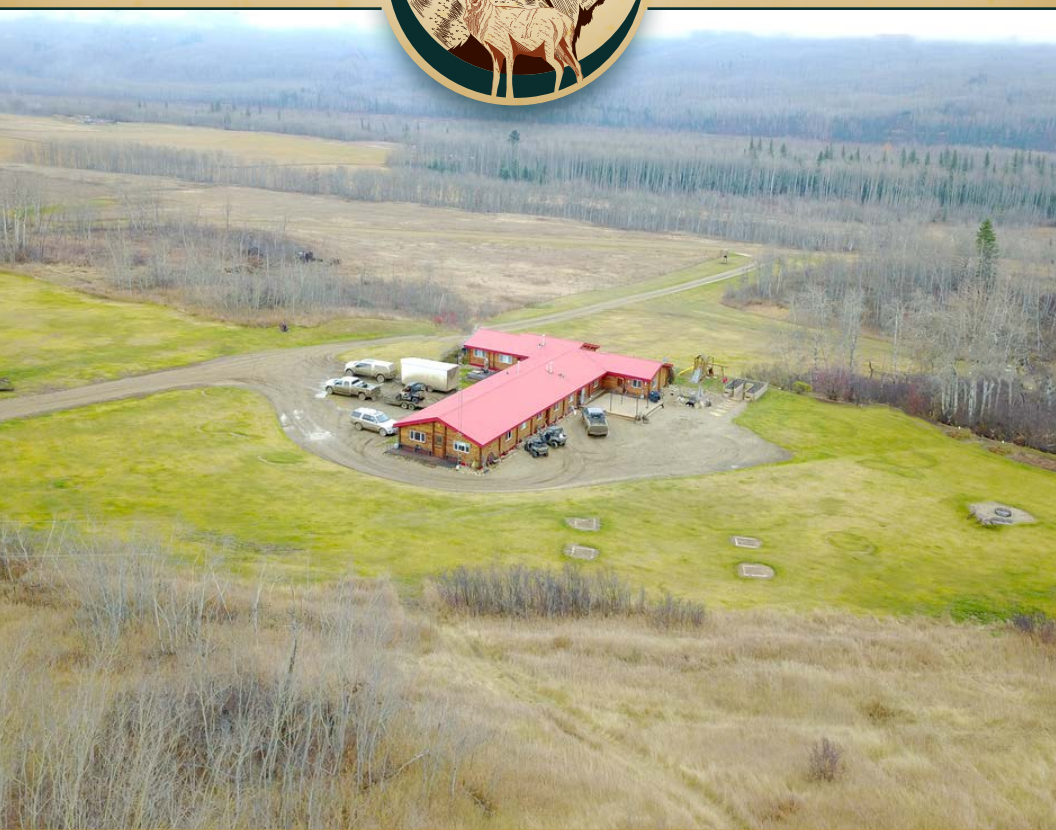
Weather

Weather is the greatest factor that can affect your hunt and determine how successful you will be. It is also the only factor that we have absolutely no control over. We will make every effort to work with the weather we get during your hunt to give you the best opportunity possible at harvesting your desired game. Following your booking you will be sent a detailed booking package that will outline the type of weather and temperature range you could expect for the time of year your hunt is to take place. It will also contain an equipment list which will include suggestions on clothing.
